



Notice of Virtual Public Meeting 2027 – 2030 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Corpus Christi District

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Corpus Christi District will conduct an online virtual public meeting for the 2027 – 2030 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP). The purpose of this meeting is to provide information and receive comments on which transportation projects may be coming to your area. The Corpus Christi District includes Aransas, Bee, Goliad, Jim Wells, Karnes, Kleberg, Live Oak, Nueces, Refugio and San Patricio counties. The Rural TIP includes all added capacity and regionally significant projects to be funded outside of MPO boundary, and within a TxDOT District during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding. This meeting offers the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed priorities. The Rural TIP is the first step on the road to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

The virtual public meeting will include a short, pre-recorded presentation explaining the Rural TIP process, lists of proposed projects by county, and an opportunity to provide your comments. The meeting materials will be available at the time and date indicated below:
